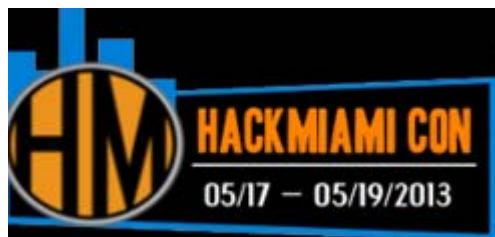


Hackers to invade South Florida for HackMiami 2013 Hacking Conference
